Prayer in the present petition is for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.692 dated 12.11.2021 registered under Sections 148/149/323/379-B/452/506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (Sections 325 and 326 of IPC have been added later on) at Police Station City Palwal, District Palwal, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in view of the judgment of the Allahabad High Court cited by the learned counsel for the complainant reported as 2020(1) Crimes 276, titled Shahaab Ali (Minor) and another Vs. State of U.P., he seeks permission of this Court to

withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner will appear before the Board within a period of 10 days from today and move an application under Section 12 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015 (hereinafter to be referred as “the Act of 2015”) and prays that for the said period of 10 days, the petitioner be not arrested.

Learned counsel for the State as well as complainant have submitted that in case, the petitioner surrenders/appears before the Board within a period of 10 days from today and moves an application under Section 12 of the Act of 2015, then for the said period of 10 days, the petitioner would not be arrested.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the direction to the petitioner to appear/surrender before the Board within a period of 10 days from today and move an application under Section 12 of the Act of 2015 which would be considered by the Board in accordance with law. For the said period of 10 days, the petitioner would not be arrested.
