Prayer in the present petition is for grant of emergency parole for the time period of 3 weeks to the petitioner on account of the fact that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is fixed for 13.11.2022, which is evident from the invitation card attached with Annexures P-2 and P-3. Petitioner is a convict and presently lodged in Central Modern Jail, Faridkot.

In compliance of order dated 07.11.2022, a reply dated 09.11.2022 by way of a short affidavit of Mr. Rajiv Kumar Arora, PPS, Superintendent, Central Jail, Faridkot has been filed by the counsel for the State, which is taken on record.

Though, there is no mention of solemnization of petitioner's daughter marriage in the affidavit dated 09.11.2022 but learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, Police Station Bajakhana

submits that the fact with regard to solemnization of petitioner's daughter marriage is correct.

In such circumstances and keeping in view the fact that the marriage of the daughter of the petitioner is going to be solemnized and in view of the statement made by the counsel for the State, this Court is of the considered opinion that the petitioner deserves the benefit of parole.

Accordingly the prayer made in the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on parole for a period of one week w.e.f. 11.11.2022 subject to the satisfaction of the competent authority. The petitioner shall surrender back with the Jail Authorities at 5.00 PM, on 17.11.2022, on the expiry of the said period.
