For the reasons stated in the application and the submissions made by counsel for the parties, the same is allowed and

Prayer in this petition is for grant of transit bail, to enable the petitioner to appear in execution proceedings initiated in Consumer Complaint Case bearing No.EA/32/2021 in CC/114/2020 filed by the complainant before the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kasaragod, Kerala.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the entire proceedings before the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kasaragod, Kerala were undertaken in the absence of the petitioner as she was never served and was proceeded *ex-parte*. It is further submitted that the petitioner is ready to pay the total amount of Rs.11,000/- including the compensation as well as the costs to the complainant Sureshan C.V. Sunil Nivas Kizhakumkara, and is also ready to appear before the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kasaragod, Kerala within a period of 02 months from today, considering the COVID-19 situation in the country especially in Kerala and prays that till the time, the petitioner appear before the District Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Kasaragod, Kerala, his arrest may be stayed.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of and the arrest of the petitioner shall remain stayed for a period of 02 months from today i.e. upto 10.03.2022.

In case, the petitioner sent a demand draft of Rs.11,000/-, favouring the complainant in the District Consumer Disputes Redressal

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Commission, Kasaragod, Kerala, it is expected that the Consumer Forum, Kasaragod, Kerala, may consider the case of the petitioner for recalling the warrants against the petitioner.
