The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.206 dated 03.11.2021 registered at Police Station Sadar Khanna, District Khanna, under Sections 323, 324, 506 IPC, wherein the offences under Sections 325 and 326 IPC are stated to have been added later-on.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Avtar Singh from the above-said Police Station, apprises the Court that in compliance of the order dated 04.01.2022 as passed by the Co-ordinate

Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and her custodial interrogation is not required and she is also not involved in any other criminal case.

In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the instant petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 04.01.2022, is hereby made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
