A suit filed by the alleged farmer against his commission agent for rendition of account from 1993 to 2001, has been held to be not maintainable while permitting the appellant to file a suit for recovery of the amount.

The First Appellate Court after considering the provisions of Order 7 Rule 2 and Order 20 Rule 16 CPC while referring to the various precedents on the point, held that such suit for rendition of account is not maintainable. The First Appellate Court has also relied upon **Anant Ram Munshi Ram vs. M/s Spedding Dinga Singh & Company and others, AIR 1960 Punjab, 415.**

Since, the liberty to file the suit for recovery has already been granted.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
