This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition was filed raising a prayer that the petitioner be released on parole for a period of eight weeks on medical grounds.

As per pleadings on record petitioner stands convicted in FIR No. 08 dated 14.02.2011, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Budhlada, District Mansa.

It was the contention raised by counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner is suffering from a severe swelling in the right abdominal region and is facing acute difficulty in breathing.

On a previous date of hearing a complete copy of the petition had been furnished to Mr.A.S.Sandhu, learned Addl. AG, Punjab and who was requested to complete instructions in the matter.

Learned State counsel, during the course of hearing today, has apprised us that the petitioner is currently confined in Central Jail, Hoshiarpur. Further more, petitioner had been granted concession of parole for a period of eight weeks on 19.01.2021 and which subsequently was extended up to 16.08.2021.

It has been submitted that the petitioner had complained of a swelling in the abdominal region and was prescribed medication and also referred to Civil Hospital, Hoshiarpur on 30.10.2021. He was examined by the specialist in a medical camp organised in the Central Jail premises at Hoshiarpur and was provided necessary treatment. On 08.01.2022 petitioner was referred to the Surgery Department in Civil Hospital, Hoshiarpur for further investigations and necessary treatment. State counsel submits that the petitioner is slated to be examined at Civil Hospital, Hoshiarpur again on 10.01.2022 i.e. today. Assurance has been furnished that requisite medical treatment would be afforded to the petitioner.

In view of the above there would be no occasion for this Court to accept the prayer made in the petition.

Dismissed.
