[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.10.2022, in CWP No.24814 of 2022 in case titled as '**Bahadur Singh versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that while adjourning CWP No.24814 of 2022 vide order dated 28.10.2022 to 29.11.2022, operation of impugned order dated 21.10.2022 was stayed.

[3] At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of notification dated 01.11.2022 *inter alia* accepting nomination papers of the petitioner, for holding re-election in terms of directions dated 28.10.2022 in CWP No.24814 of 2022 for the post of Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Khodma and also to keep poll for the post of Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat Khodma, Block Narnaul, District Narnaul scheduled to be held on 02.11.2022 in abeyance with revised schedule to be issued in due course of time. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to

learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in

view of the aforementioned notification, he does not press the instant petition.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
