The petitioner has assailed the order dated 26.09.2019 passed by the Court of learned Addl. Principal Judge, Family Court, Faridabad vide which interim maintenance to the tune of Rs. 15,000/- p.m. has been awarded in favour of the respondent.

Learned counsel for the respondent contends that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties, the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. in the Court below has been dismissed as withdrawn and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertions of the learned counsel for the respondent, the petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

As none has joined the proceedings on behalf of the petitioner, the petitioner shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition within two months in the event, the assertions as projected hereinabove are found to be factually incorrect.
