The petitioner herein seeks a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing transfer deed dated 11.06.2014 (Annexure P-2) which is against the provisions of the Indian Stamp Act and the Registration Act.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner would submit that for his grievance, the petitioner had served a legal notice/representation dated 06.12.2020 upon respondent No.2, however, it has not been decided till date. Counsel would submit that the petitioner would be satisfied in case his said legal notice/representation is decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Deepali Puri, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let adequate number of copies of the paper book be supplied to her during the course of the day.

Without commenting on merits of the case and keeping in view the limited prayer made by counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide legal notice/representation dated 06.12.2020, Annexure P-3, of the petitioner within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law and convey the decision to the petitioner. In case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse would be liable to costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited with the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates Welfare Fund.
