The present Regular Second Appeal has been filed by the
plaintiffs.

It has been stated by both the learned counsels for the parties that
the suit for possession for specific performance filed by the respondents-
plaintiffs was partly decreed and alternate relief of refund of money was
granted.

Both the plaintiffs and the defendant have filed two separate
appeal before the Additional District Judge, Fatehgarh Sahib and the both the
said appeals were dismissed.

Thereafter, two appeals have been filed before this Court. One
bearing RSA-3061-2012 filed by the respondent-defendant and the other
bearing RSA-842-2016 having been filed by appellants-plaintiffs .

The parties submit that the matter has been compromised and the
matter was referred to the Lok Adalat vide order dated 15.07.2022 by a co-
ordinate Bench of this Court. The said order is reproduced hereunder:-

*“Present application has been filed for withdrawal of the
main revision petition, as the matter has been compromised
between the parties. Also, a prayer is made for return of the Court*

fee, filed along with the Memorandum of Appeal.

Considering the same, let the matter be taken up in the Lok Adalat to be held in the month August 2022.

Also, it is submitted by learned counsel that there is a connected appeal filed by the parties i.e. RSA-842-2016, which is stated to be fixed in the month of November, 2022. Said appeal be also put up before the Lok Adalat along with the present appeal.
