This petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.2 to 4 to consider and decide representation/complaint dated 26.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) submitted by the petitioner and to take appropriate steps against the accused persons and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner from the persons who are interfering into petitioner's life.

Given the nature of this case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the petition at this stage without issuing notice to official respondents as Members of the Bar are abstaining from work today.

On perusal of the records, let this petition be disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla to consider and decide the representation/complaint dated 26.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioner seeking protection for her life and liberty.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits of the claim of the petitioner and even the assertions set out in the petition, the present

petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2 that if any such representation/complaint, as indicated above, is indeed pending consideration, it shall be dealt with expeditiously in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and conveying the same to the petitioner.

The present petition stands disposed off accordingly.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Malerkotla.
