VINOD S. BHARDWAJ. J (ORAL)

The present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus raising a challenge to the decision of the respondent Insurance Company whereby the insurance claim on account of Jatinder Singh having died due to accident is not being released.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that the denial of the insurance benefits is being justified by alleging that it was a case of suicide whereas there is no evidence to justify the aforesaid stand. He further contends that such denial is misconceived and not tangible.

Taking into consideration the fact that the disputed questions arise for determination and the petitioner would have an efficacious remedy to approach the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services) under the Legal Services Authority Act, 1987, or under the other Statutory and Common Laws for redressal of his grievances, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition so as to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
