The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 4 to decide the representation/complaint dated 02.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) and also the representation dated 25.08.2022 (Annexure P-4) in a pending dispute inter se amongst the petitioner and private respondents.

After arguing at some length, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to take recourse to the alternative remedies available to the petitioner in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
