The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to the State not to harass the petitioner and his wife on the ground that their son is nominated in FIR No.165 dated 23.08.2019 registered under Sections 376, 506, 370, 420 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Dehlon, district Ludhiana.

In response to the notice issued by this Court the State has filed an affidavit as per which they denied any harassment meted out to the petitioner. Rather, it is stated that the petitioner's son is involved in a rape case and since he was absconded they were raiding the petitioner's house to arrest his son. However, the investigation in the case against the petitioner's son is complete and, therefore, there is no occasion for the petitioner's harassment.

In the light of the afore development, no further orders are

required to be passed in the present petition.
