Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has secured 91 marks in the selection carried out by the respondents for the post of Shift Attendant. He also submits that the last selected candidate in the general category has also secured 91 marks, but the petitioner being elder in age would be entitled to preference in appointment. He also submits that one mark for NCC (B) certificate has not been awarded to the petitioner although he was qualified and eligible for the same. He has sent a legal notice (Annexure P16) in this regard to the respondents on 01.07.2022, but no action has been taken thereon. He further submits that respondent No. 2 may be directed to consider and decide the legal notice (Annexure P16).

Issue notice to the respondents.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Anant Kataria, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 1.

Mr. Dushyant Saharan, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No. 2.

Heard.

The petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 01.07.2022 (Annexure P16), in accordance with law, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
