The present petition has been preferred against order dated 04.03.2017, passed by the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Malerkotla (for short, the Trial Court) through which an application filed by the respondent under Section 127 Cr.P.C. has been accepted resulting in the issuance of a direction to the petitioner to pay to the respondent monthly maintenance @ Rs.8,000/-. Also under challenge is the order dated 13.02.2019, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur (for short – the Revisional Court) through which a revision petition filed by the petitioner against the aforesaid order of the Trial Court was dismissed.

The respondent filed an application under Section 125 Cr.P.C. which was allowed by the Trial Court on 21.07.2009 resulting in issuance of a direction to the petitioner to pay to the respondent monthly maintenance @ 1500/-. The petitioner filed a revision petition against the aforesaid order of the Trial Court which was dismissed on 17.11.2009. Thereafter on 15.04.2015 on the ground of inflation as also increase in the petitioner's salary the respondent filed an application under Section 127 Cr.P.C. seeking enhancement in the maintenance already awarded to her. Such application was allowed by the Trial Court after considering the rise in prices of essential commodities as also

because of increase of the petitioner's monthly salary to about Rs.28,000/-.

After going through the concurrent findings returned by the Trial Court as also the Revisional Court, this Court is of the opinion that in the light of the petitioner's monthly salary having been determined @ Rs.28,000/- (approximately), grant of Rs.8,000/- as monthly maintenance to the respondent is reasonable and therefore warrants no interference by this Court.
