The petitioner herein has approached this Court seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the provisional list of selected

candidates for the post of Information Technology Officer (I.T.O.) in Punjab Bureau of Investigation (PBI) on the ground that persons with lesser merit than the petitioner have been put in the select list.

Similar grievance, as raised in the present writ petition, had been raised in a bunch of writ petitions decided on 05.12.2022 in CWP No.27099 of 2022 titled *Harshpreet Singh Jeffey and others Versus State of Punjab and others*. In the said bunch of petitions, this Court had been apprised by the ADGP, Community Affairs, Punjab, who appeared in person in the Court on that day, that a number of candidates have already raised their grievance with regard to the provisional select lists of different categories and in this respect, a Sub Committee has been constituted which is looking up their issues. The said Committee is being headed by Mr. Rajesh Jaswal, IGP, who is also a member of the Recruitment Board. Accordingly, those writ petitioners were relegated to be heard before the Sub Committee, which shall redress their grievance by passing a speaking order.

This writ petition is also disposed of with the similar directions as it is stated by the State counsel that the Sub Committee is still seized of the matter and is considering the grievances of the candidates.
