The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

In terms of order dated 18.11.2022, learned State counsel has filed status report by way of affidavit of Daljit Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub-Division, Garshshankar, District Hoshiarpur. A copy of the statements of the petitioners and respondents No. 1,2 and 3 are also annexed with the status report.

Learned State counsel further submits that the petitioners are living happily in the matrimonial home and they do not want to obtain the police security, so, this petition is hereby disposed of as having become infructuous. However, in case, the petitioners requires any security on the apprehension of life and liberty at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 6, they are free to approach the police authority for security.
