Instant writ petition was filed seeking a mandamus directing the respondents under the Haryana Excise and Taxation Department to issue a licence L-4/5 in favour of the petitioner who is otherwise running a restaurant in Gurugram.

Since an advance copy of the petition already stood served upon the respondents, Ms. Shruti Jain Goyal, learned DAG, Haryana has entered appearance and informs the Court that the application submitted by the petitioner for grant of licence L-4/5 was considered by a duly constituted Joint Committee headed by the Deputy Commissioner, Gurugram and in the proceedings/deliberations that ensued a decision has been taken not to grant such licence in favour of the petitioner. Learned State counsel further submits that a final order of rejection would be conveyed to the petitioner within a period of two weeks from today.

In the light of such development, the prayer made in the instant petition cannot be accepted.

Writ petition is disposed of.

Suffice it to observe that upon receipt of rejection order it would always be open for the petitioner to take legal recourse in accordance with law.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
