Respondent No.2 was appointed as Lambardar of the village and appeal and revision filed by the petitioner have been dismissed. Thus, the present writ petition has been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that an FIR No.113, dated 07.09.2022 under Sections 323, 324 & 34 IPC has been registered against respondent No.2. He is also involved in interference into the peaceful possession of a third person and a civil suit regarding the same is pending as is evident from interim order dated 27.09.2017 (Annexure P-8). Thus, it is evident that respondent No.2 is quarrelsome by nature. This aspect has not been considered by any of the authorities.

The submissions are not entitled to acceptance. Being a party in civil suit is not a disqualification for consideration for the post of Lambardar. FIR dated 07.09.2022 also cannot be relied upon as the same has come into being after conclusion of the proceedings for appointment of Lambardar.

The writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
