ALOK JAIN, J. :

Vide order dated 16.01.2020, the matter was referred to the
Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court.

Vide report dated 05.02.2020, a settlement has been arrived at
between the parties in respect of RSA Nos.3886 and 4395 of 2014.
Accordingly, RSA No.5951 of 2014, which was tagged along with these
two appeals is ordered to be segregated from the bunch of these appeals.

Vide settlement dated 05.02.2020, it has been agreed in the
following terms:

“ xx xx xx

3. *During the pendency of the appeal the matter has
been amicably settled between the parties which was*

referred to the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court by the Hon'ble Court vide order dated 16.01.2020. In compliance with the said orders both the parties have appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre on 05.02.2020, i.e. today and submitted their photocopies of affidavits duly attested by the Notary Public dated 06.09.2018 (two affidavits), 24.05.2018 and 06.08.2018 "Annexures A1 to A4", in which Surjit Kaur (deceased), Lakhwinder Kaur, Gurbachan Kaur and Joginder Kaur i.e. the respondent Nos.1 to 4 have admitted the due execution of the Will dated 03.03.2023 and relinquished their rights and title in respect of the suit property qua their share in favour of the present appellants and have no objection if the decree is modified to that extent and entry made in the revenue record and thus would not claim any rights or title in future."

Learned counsel for the parties have made a joint prayer for disposal of RSA Nos. 3886 and 4395 of 2014, in terms of the settlement.

Ordered accordingly.

It has also been brought to the notice of this Court that Mr. Adesh Partap Singh-appellant, who was minor at the time of filing of the appeal has attained majority and is present in the Court, which fact is verified by learned counsel for the appellants.

Copy of the settlement arrived at between the parties be made a part of the decree and both the parties shall remain bound by the terms of the said compromise.
