The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C seeking quashing of FIR No. 196 dated 30.12.2015 under Sections 354-A, 323 and 34 of IPC registered at Police Station Division No.2, District Jalandhar and all consequential proceedings arising thereof, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for the petitioners has stated that the present petition is for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise arrived at between the parties which fact is affirmed by learned counsel for the respondents No.2 to 4.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh has submitted that all prosecution witnesses have been examined by the trial Court.

In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present

petition with liberty to the petitioners to avail alternate remedy as available to them under the law.

Dismissed as withdrawn, with aforesaid liberty.
