This petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to safeguard the life and liberty of the petitioners solemnized their marriage on 03.11.2022, against the wishes of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Given the nature of the case, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the petition at this stage without issuing notice to official respondents as members of the Bar are abstaining from work today.

In the present matter, petitioner No.2-Kulvir Singh S/o Gurtej Singh is not having marriageable age, however, he has performed marriage with petitioner No.1-Harpreet Kaur (major) on 03.11.2022.

Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the matter and in particular the legality of the alleged relationship, the present petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur to consider and decide the representation dated 03.11.2022 (Annexure P-5) alleged to have been submitted by the petitioners and thereafter, take appropriate action on the same as is deemed fit in accordance with law to ensure the protection of life and liberty of the petitioners.

It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to validate the alleged relationship between the petitioners or protect them from legal action for violation, if any, committed by them.

A copy of this order be sent to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Sangrur.
