1. Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 19.09.2022, in CWP-21378-2022.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-21378-2022 along with connected cases was disposed of as not pressed with liberty to the petitioner to move a representation raising the grievances as raised in the writ petition with those of the petitioner(s) who had not been relieved, being allowed to continue at the existing place of posting till decision of the representation and in case they had already been relieved from the place of posting, they would not be forced to join at the new place of posting till the decision of the representation.

3. Although notice has not yet been issued in the case, yet, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of order dated 14.11.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal

thereof states that in view of rejection of claim of the petitioner as

contained in representation filed by the petitioner, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 14.11.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
