[1] Prayer in the instant petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1 dated 19.05.2022 in CWP-10760-2022

[2] A perusal of order Annexure P-1 reveals that CWP-10760-2022 was disposed of in view of assurance held out by the learned State counsel that appropriate order on the revision petition filed by the late husband of the petitioner challenging his compulsory retirement would be passed if not already passed, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned AAG, Punjab has produced copy of order dated 26.10.2022 passed by the Additional Chief Secretary Financial Commissioner Revenue, Punjab, Chandigarh dismissing the appeal. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal of the same, states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the

petitionerchallenge order dated 26.10.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
