On 09.11.2022, following order was passed by this Court:

Prayer in the instant petition, filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No. 2 and 3, to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner from the hands of respondents No. 4 to 8.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner -Gaganpreet Kaur, aged about 28 years, is married to one Dulla Singh.

Due to harassment and threats caused by said Dulla Singh, (husband of the petitioner), petitioner has submitted a representation dated 01.11.2022 (Annexure P-2) to respondent No. 2-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, wherein, she has expressed her apprehension. As of now, petitioner is staying with one Des Raj Singh s/o Sukhchain Singh, resident

of Village Gag Kalan, Tehsil Jagroan, District Ludhiana with the purpose to take shelter.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. J.S. Arora, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 (State). He seeks time to file reply/status report.

Adjourned to 29.11.2022

Reply/status report be filed on or before the next date of hearing.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Baljinder Kumar, submits that proceedings under Sections 107 and 151 Cr. P.C. have already been initiated against respondents No. 7 and 8.

In view of the stand taken by learned State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage.

Dismissed as withdrawn, at this stage.
