DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of their lives and personal liberty, in view of the threats received from respondents No. 4 to 7, who are family members of petitioner No. 1.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that both the petitioners are major, aged 18 years and 19 years 10 months respectively and have performed marriage against the wishes of their parents which was solemnized on 03.11.2022. In support thereof, photographs of marriage (Annexure P-1), copies of Aadhaar Cards pertaining to the petitioners (Annexures P-2 and P-3) have also been appended.

It is further submitted that a representation dated 03.11.2022 (Annexure P-4) has also been sent by the petitioners to the respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, which has not been taken into consideration, in spite of being threatened by respondent Nos. 4 to 7.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy, Ms. Ishneet Kaur, Assistant AG

if appropriate directions are given for deciding the representation submitted by the petitioners.

As the petitioner No. 2 is major but not of marriageable age, therefore, without examining the question of legality and validity of the marriage and expressing any opinion thereon, the petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, to look into the grievances of the petitioners as set out in the petition and also expressed in the representation (Annexure P-4) and take appropriate action for protection of their lives and liberty as may be warranted by the circumstances.

The Registry is directed to send a copy of this order along with copy of the petition to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, District Ludhiana, for requisite compliance.

Pending application, if any, also stand disposed of.

The petition is disposed of.
