Through instant petition under Section 438 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 179 dated 9.10.2022 registered at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda under Sections 384, 386, 387, 506 and 120-B IPC (Sections 25/27/54/59 of Arms Act and Section 411 IPC added subsequently

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to order dated 10.11.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation on 14.11.2022.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Surjit Singh does not dispute the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner and further submits that petitioner has joined investigation and custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 10.11.2022 is made absolute

subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C.

If the petitioner or his family members/associates make any attempt to threat/intimidate the witnesses in the present case, the State would be at liberty to move an application for cancellation of bail granted by this order.
