ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 439(2) Cr.P.C. for cancellation of bail granted to respondents No.2 to 6 by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri by setting aside the order dated 03.10.2019 (Annexure P-1) in FIR No.99 dated 09.09.2019 under Sections 148, 149, 323, 427, 452, 506 IPC and 3(2) of the SC/ST Act 1989 registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be contended in case her life is protected at the hands of the accused by imposing more conditions.

Learned counsel for the private respondents submits that he would have no objection provided that bails of the accused are not cancelled.

Given above, the petition is partly allowed and following conditions shall be part of order dated 03.10.2019 (Annexure P-1):-

- a) that the accused shall surrender all weapons, firearms, ammunition, if any, along with the arms license to the concerned authority within 30 days from today and inform the Investigator about the compliance. However, subject to the Indian Arms Act, 1959, the petitioners shall be entitled to renew and take it back in case of acquittal in this case.
- b) that the accused shall stay at a distance of 100 mtr away from the house of the complainant till the recording of the statements.
