Prayer in the present petition is for quashing of FIR No.36 dated 14.08.2020, under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women-2, Amritsar, Final report/Police Report as well as orders framing charges/chargesheet (Annexure P-3) along with consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be allowed to withdraw the present petition with liberty to avail his remedies as available under law. He has also prayed that the petitioner be allowed to file his application for personal exemption.

Allowed to do so.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for. In case the petitioner files an application for exemption from his personal appearance before the trial Court, the trial Court is directed to decide the same in accordance with law and in case the trial Court allows the same, it will be free to impose any reasonable condition upon the petitioner.
