[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 22.09.2022 in CRM-M No.43997 of 2022 in case titled as Charanjit Singh and another vs. State of Punjab and others.

[2] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 reveals that CRM-M No.43997 of 2022 was disposed of by directing the respondent to consider and decide representation dated 29.08.2022.

[3] Learned AAG has filed compliance report-cum-reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Sandeep Kumar Garg, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAG Nagar, Mohali along with order, Annexure R-1/T dated 29.10.2022 and report, Annexure R-2/T dated 09.12.2022. The orders are taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioners, who on perusal thereof states that in view of order, Annexure R-1/T dated 29.10.2022 rejecting the claim of the petitioners as contained in the representation 29.08.2022, he does not press the instant

petitionbut prays for grant of liberty to the petitioners to challenge order, Annexure R-1/T dated 29.10.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the instantpetition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 while granting liberty to the petitioners as prayed for.
