B.S. Walia, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 03.06.2016, in CWP-12099-2016.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-12099-2016, was disposed of by directing the official respondents to consider and take a decision with regard to the petitioner's claim, after affording opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and private respondents and if the petitioner's grievance was found to be justified, to take necessary action against the private respondents in view of representation/complaint dated 31.08.2016.

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that substantial compliance has been done in terms of order Annexure P/1 but some work remains to be done therefore while he does not press the instant petition but prays for issuance of directions to respondent No. 5 to complete the remaining work in a time bound manner.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents on instructions from respondent No.5 states that needful would be done within two months

from today.

5. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

6. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing respondent No.5 to adhere to the assurance held out by him through the learned counsel representing him and to complete the remaining work within two months from today.

7. Rule discharged. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to move application for revival of the instant petition if needful is not done as per assurance noted above.

8. Pending misc. application, if any, also stand disposed of.
