[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 22.07.2022, in CWP No.15702 of 2022in case titled as 'Ramphal versus State of Haryana and others.'

[2] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to order (Annexure P-1), the respondent has passed a fresh order dated 25.11.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 06.08.2020.

[3] Order dated 25.11.2022 is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 25.11.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
