Challenge laid in this appeal is to the judgment of conviction dated 17.10.2016 and order of sentence dated 20.10.2016, vide which the appellant was convicted for the offence punishable under Sections 307, 353, 392, 397 of the IPC and Section 25(1-B)(a) of the Arms Act and was sentence to undergo a maximum sentence of seven years and to pay a fine of Rs. 7,000/- with default clause.

Custody certificate, filed by learned State counsel in Court today, is taken on record.

A perusal of the custody certificate reflects that the appellant has already undergone the entire sentence awarded by the trial Court.

Learned State counsel submits that the appellant is involved in a number of other cases, out of which, in some of the cases, he has been acquitted and in some cases, he is either on bail or undergoing the sentence. It is further submitted that the appellant has also been convicted under Section 302 IPC and sentenced to life imprisonment, vide judgment of

conviction and order of sentence dated 20.01.2015, passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Kurukshetra and in the said case, he has undergone 13 years, 04 months and 13 days of sentence and is still in custody.

Learned counsel for the appellant has not disputed the factual position.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the fact that the appellant is involved in many other case and is undergoing life imprisonment in a case under Section 302 IPC and also in view of the fact that he has undergone entire sentence in the present case, the present appeal is disposed of.
