In compliance with orders dated 23.09.2022 and 10.10.2022 passed by this Court, report of Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court has been received, stating that the parties have settled their disputes arisen in the appeal by way of an amicable settlement/agreement dated 19.09.2022 (Annexure A-1).

Parties along with their counsel are present in Court. In terms of the aforesaid compromise, total amount of Rs.1,15,00,000/-(Rs.One Crore Fifteen Lakh only) by way of demand drafts bearing No.610428, 610429, 610430, 610431, 610432, 610433 and 610434 dated 24.08.2022, amounting to Rs.57,50,000/-, Rs.10,00,000/-, Rs.10,00,000/-, Rs.10,00,000/-, Rs.10,00,000/-, Rs.10,00,000/- and Rs.7,50,000/- respectively, has been paid today by appellant to respondents No.1 and 2.

In view of the compromise having been arrived at between the parties and on the request of parties, civil miscellaneous application bearing CM No.7094-C of 2022 seeking disposal of the present appeal, i.e., RSA No.4728 of 2014, is taken on board today. The said application is allowed and, accordingly, the present appeal is ordered to be disposed of in terms of the compromise dated 19.09.2022 (Annexure A-1), which shall form part of the decree.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
