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Application is allowed, as prayed for.

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In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that though he had submitted an experience certificate but the same has not been considered by the respondents while considering the claim of the petitioner for the post of PGT Fine Arts whereas the similar experience certificate given by one Sunita, has been accepted and she has been given marks for the said experience certificate hence, petitioner has been discriminated. The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of a direction to the respondent-Commission to grant the petitioner the benefit of experience certificate and re-calculate his merit.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner

has already raised the said grievance in the legal notice dated 16/26.09.2022 (Annexure P-10) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to respondent No. 2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the legal notice dated 16/26.09.2022 (Annexure P-10) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the legal notice, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the legal notice dated 16/26.09.2022 (Annexure P-10), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
