DEEPAK MANCHANDA J.

The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking extension of parole for a period of 2 months to the father of the petitioner on medical grounds.

Learned counsel for the petitioner stated that father of the petitioner was convicted and sentenced for 12 years under NDPS Act in case bearing FIR No. 131 of the year 2002 at Police Station Sadar Nabha, District Patiala and the sentence was reduced to 10 years by this Court. It is further contended that father of the petitioner was granted parole on 04.10.2022 for a period of 4 weeks and he had to surrender on 05.11.2022 but due to depression and serious health problems, father of the petitioner could not surrender on time and request has been made to extend the parole of father of the petitioner for a period of 2 months.

Notice of motion was issued and learned State counsel had sought time to seek instructions regarding health conditions of father of the petitioner.

In pursuance to the same, Discharge Summary has been filed today in the Court by learned State counsel, as per which father of the petitioner has been advised for follow up in Neurology Department after 7 days.

Learned counsel for the petitioner now has prayed for extension of parole of the father of the petitioner on the ground of medical exigency and he has referred to the details given in para No. 9 of the petition.

I have heard the counsel for the parties and have gone through the case file.

Keeping in view the medical condition of father of the petitioner and advice given by the doctors vide Discharge Summary dated 15.11.2022 submitted by learned State counsel, parole of the father of petitioner, namely Ajit Singh is extended only for a period of 8 days from today, who shall surrender before the jail authorities on 25.11.2022 by 05.00 P.M.

The present petition is disposed of in aforesaid terms.
