In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioners is that the petitioners have not been granted the benefits in terms of the judgment rendered in CWP No.2866 of 2014, titled as “***Karanvir Singh and others vs State of Punjab and others***”, decided on 30.09.2016.

After issuing notice of motion, in the reply, the respondents have mentioned that the petitioners have already been granted the benefits as found entitled for keeping in view the ***Karanvir Singh's*** case (*supra*) and no further payments are to be made to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners be given liberty to approach the respondents in case, any of the benefits for which they are entitled in terms of the ***Karanvir Singh's*** case (*supra*) have not been extended so far.

Learned State counsel submits that if any representation is filed by the petitioners raising any grievance, the same will be dealt with in accordance with law and an appropriate order on the same will be passed within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of the copy of the representation.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been not pressed with liberty as prayed for.

Ordered accordingly.
