Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for the grievances raised by the petitioner through the instant petition she has also filed representations dated 21.09.2021 and 07.03.2022 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) which are still pending consideration with the respondents and that, at this stage, he would be satisfied if the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider in a time bound manner and take a final decision on the grievance(s) raised by the petitioner in her afore representations.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the afore prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to finally decide the representations dated 21.09.2021 and 07.03.2022 (Annexures P-3 and P-4) made by the petitioner by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

Needless to add that the decision so taken be communicated to the petitioner and if the decision is not to the satisfaction of the petitioner, she would be at liberty to challenge the same, in accordance with law.
