In the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that she has been relieved from service on the ground that the workload has reduced hence, the service of the petitioner, who was working as Extension Lecturer in the subject of Zoology, is not required any further with respondent No.5-Institution.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the respondents have wrongly ascertained the workload so as to relieve the petitioner whereas, in case the workload is ascertained keeping in view the guidelines issued by the respondent-State of Haryana, the petitioner is entitled to continue in service.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 22.10.2022 (Annexure P-5) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Harish Nain, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 22.10.2022 (Annexure P-5) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the pleadings in the present petition, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the representation, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 22.10.2022 (Annexure P-5), by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
