[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 13.09.2022, in CWP-20784-2022 in case titled as '**Neelam Devi versus State of Haryana and others**'.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1) reveals that CWP-20784-2022 was disposed of by directing the respondents to look into the representation dated 08.08.2022 and pass a speaking order in respect thereto in accordance with law in any case, not later than four weeks to avoid creation of any third party rights.

[3] At the outset, learned DAG, Haryana, has produced copy of speaking order dated 20.12.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in representation dated 08.08.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that in the circumstances, he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 20.12.2022 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance

[4] In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
