[1] Learned counsel for the respondents has filed memo of appearance in Court today. The same is taken on record.

[2] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 26.02.2019 in CWP No.17136 of 2016 in case titled as Manjeet Chandila vs. Haryana State Agriculture Marketing Board and others.

[3] A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 26.02.2019 reveals that CWP No.17136 of 2016 was disposed of by setting aside order, Annexure P/10 passed by the respondent-Board and directing them to consider the matter afresh in the light of decision in CWP No.3292 of 2012 in case titled as Sumer Singh vs. Haryana State Agricultural Marketing Board and others decided on 11.02.2014 and to pass a speaking order as expeditiously as possible, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[4] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that needful in terms of order, Annexure P/1 has been done and the claim of the petitioner considered but rejected vide order dated 11.12.2019 and that the petitioner has challenged said decision by way of CWP No.20243 of 2020, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner does not wish to pursue the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same.

[5] In view of the position noted above as well as the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
