This is a petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of Certiorari quashing the impugned award dated 21.01.2016 (Annexure P-7) passed by the Labour Court, Circle-1, Faridabad, whereby the respondent No.2-workman has been ordered to be reinstated in service with continuity of service with back wages w.e.f. 01.06.2011.

The counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the award passed by the Labour Court has been fully satisfied by way of amicable settlement with respondent No.2-workman. The respondent No.2-workman has forgone the claim qua reinstatement in lieu of monetary compensation. The said monetary compensation has already been paid to respondent No.2-workman. Hence, the present petition has been rendered infructuous on account of compliance of the award passed by the Labour Court.

The counsel for respondent No.2-workman on instructions from respondent-workman, who is present in the Court and is assisting the counsel, has also not disputed the factum of settlement and compliance of the award as desired by him.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous on account of the petitioner having satisfied with the award.

All pending miscellaneous applications are also disposed of as such.
