The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No. 142 dated 19.09.2022 under Sections 18, 27-A and 29 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for some time and seeing that this Court is not inclined to interfere in the matter and in order to avoid any adverse order, seeks to withdraw the present petition and states that the petitioner would surrender within a period of two weeks from today and states that after surrender, the petitioner would apply for regular bail and prays that in case, he applies for regular bail after surrender then the trial Court be requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 15 days from the date of the application.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

The petitioner is directed to surrender before the police within a period of 2 weeks from today.

In case, after surrendering before the police within a period of 2 weeks from today, the petitioner files an application for grant of regular bail, the trial Court is requested to decide the same as expeditiously as possible preferably within a period of 15 days from the date of filing of the said application.

It is made clear that the said regular bail application would be decided by the trial Court independently on the basis of the merits of the case uninfluenced by the present order passed by this Court.
