Through this first petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.165 dated 21.10.2022, registered at Police Station Nathana, District Bathinda, under Sections 304 and 34 IPC.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition. However, he submits that the petitioner would surrender before the Court of Session within ten days positively and move an application seeking relief of regular bail there. He further prays that the concerned Court be directed to decide the said bail application of the petitioner within some specific time frame.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, in case the petitioner surrenders before the Court of Session within ten days from today and moves an application seeking the

relief of regular bail there, the same shall be decided at the earliest, as per law.
