The petitioner, challenging the impugned order dated 28.10.2022 (Annexure P-8) passed by the learned Special Judicial Magistrate, CBI, Punjab, Mohali, vide which his prayer for going abroad was declined, has come up before this Court seeking quashing of the said order.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner wants to go abroad to meet his son and grand children, who are permanent residents of Australia and blessed with daughter some time back, for a period of two months. He further submits that next date before the trial Court is now fixed for 21.01.2023 and the petitioner would return before the next date of hearing before the trial Court.

Given above, the petitioner is permitted to travel abroad, subject to the condition that he shall keep his mobile phone 'ON', recharge it with international validity and should also keep its internet 'ON' throughout his visit. He shall have whatsapp installed and share the mobile number, IMEI number and whatsapp details with the investigator. Further,

he shall declare/inform his date of departure as well as return to the investigator through counsel for the CBI. He shall also provide the address where he will stay in Australia and on his return, he shall intimate the concerned investigator about the same.

Petition is allowed in the terms mentioned above and the impugned order dated 28.10.2022 (P-8) is set aside. Pending applications, if any, stand disposed of.
