This is the second petition for grant of regular bail in FIR No.208, dated 17.09.2020, under Sections 302, 449, 148, 149, 506, 212, 419, 420, 427, 460, 109, 465, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC and under Sections 25, 27, 54 and 59 of Arms Act and under Section 12 of the Passport Act, 1967, registered at Police Station City Kharar, District SAS Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though in the afore-said FIR, petitioner has already been granted the regular bail by this Court vide order dated 31.08.2022 passed in CRM-M-16925-2022 but inadvertently offences under Sections 419, 471 and 212 IPC were not mentioned.

In the earlier petition i.e. CRM-M-16925-2022, the petitioner

had been granted the bail considering the fact that eye witnesses have turned
