1. Prayer in the petition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1, dated 10.08.2022, in CWP-17715-2022.

2. A perusal of order Annexure P/1 reveals that CWP-17715-2022, was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide legal notice dated 21.02.2022, within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and to convey the decision to the petitioner and in case of failure to do so, the officer responsible for the lapse was made liable to pay costs of Rs.20,000/- from his personal pocket, to be deposited in the Punjab and Haryana High Court Advocates' Welfare Fund.

3. Learned AAG, Punjab, has produced copy of speaking order dated 02.12.2022, rejecting the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 21.02.2022. The same is taken on record. Copy thereof supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who on perusal thereof states that he does not press the instant petition but prays for grant of liberty to the petitioner to challenge order dated 02.12.2022, by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
