The Prayer in this petition is for quashing of FIR No.14 dated 16.01.2015 (Annexure **P-8**) under Sections 212, 216, 389, 420 and 120-B IPC registered with Police Station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhiana which is a sheer abuse of the process of law and a counter blast to the FIR NO.223 dated 18.10.2014 under Section 294, 506, 34 IPC and later on added offence under Sections 3,4,5 (L), 14, 15, 16 & 17 of The Protection of Children From Sexual Offences Act, offence under Section 377 IPC and Offence under Section 4, 66 of The Immoral Traffic Act, registered with the the same very police station Division No.5, Civil Lines, Ludhinana (Annexure P-1) against the daughter and sons of the

complainant/respondent no.2.

None has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioners and similar was the situation on the last three occasions.

The learned State Counsel submits that a compromise has been effected between the parties and in view of the same the aforementioned FIR stands quashed vide order dated 27.09.2022 passed in CRM-M-22249-2022 titled as Harjinder Singh & Anr. Vs. State of Punjab & Anr. The copy of the order dated 27.09.2022 is marked as 'X'.

In view of the above, the preset petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
