The present petition has been filed under 482 Cr.P.C praying for issuance of directions to respondents no.1 to 4 for conducting a fair and impartial inquiry in case FIR No.0107 dated 20.4.2022 registered under sections 341, 354, 354-D and 506 IPC at Police Station, Cantonment, Amritsar by forming a S.I.T of the rank of A.C.P.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Sandeep Kumar, D.A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 to 4.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would be satisfied, if, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to take a decision on the representation dated 7.9.2022 (Annexure P-7) already submitted by the petitioners expeditiously and in a time bound manner.

I find the prayer to be just and reasonable.

In view of the above position, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no.3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to decide the representation dated 7.9.2022 (Annexure P-7) already submitted by the petitioners within a period of one month from today in accordance with law.
